
Unsend and Edit Messages

Unsend - can undo of up to 2 minutes after sending

- 1. Go to Messages app
- 2. Touch and hold the message bubble, tap Undo Send

Note: You must be using iMessage with iOS 16, iPadOS 16.1 or later

If you unsend a message using an earlier operating system, the original message remains in the conversation and you are notified that the recipient may still see the original message.



Edit - can edit a recently sent message up to 5 times within 15 minutes of sending

- 1. Select a conversation with the message you want to edit
- 2. Touch and hold the message bubble, tap Edit
- 3. Make the changes, tap checkmark to resend, X to revert

Note: the message is marked as Edited in the conversation transcript. The message bubble updates to reflect your edits on both your iPhone and your recipient's device and both of you can tap Edited to see previous versions of your message



Schedule a Message Up to 14 days in the future



- 1. Go to the Messages app on your iPhone
- 2. Tap the plus sign +, then tap Send Later
- 3. Tap the time to open the scheduler, then choose when you want to send your message

(The border of the text field turns turns into a dashed line, and the time your message will be sent appears above the message)

4. Enter a message, then tap 1


NOTE: Scheduled messages are encrypted and stored on Apple servers only until they are sent. When a message is sent, it is removed from Apple servers, the balloon becomes a solid color and its dashed line disappears.

Change the Time to Send a Message

You can reschedule a message until its delivery time

- 1. Go to the messages app
- 2. Go to the conversation with the message you want to reschedule
- 3. Scroll to the bottom of the conversation if you don't see your message (scheduled messages may appear below other sent messages)
- 4. Tap Edit beside the date (above your scheduled message) then do any

of the following:



1. Reschedule it: Tap Edit Time, choose a new time, then tap away


Delete Message

Edit Time

- from the schedule to commit the new time.
- 2. Send it immediately: Tap Send Message
- 3. Delete the message: Tap Delete


Edit or Delete a Scheduled Message

You can edit a scheduled message until its delivery time



Repeat previous steps

- 1. Touch and hold the message bubble, then tap Edit
- 2. Make changes, then tap check mark to resend with edits or x to revert



Add Effects to a Message

Style and Effects

- 1. Go to the Message app
- 2. In a new or existing conversation, enter a message
- 3. Select the text you want to format
- 4. Tap the A above keyboard
- 5. Select preferred style (bold, italic, underline, strikethrough)
- 6. OR animated effects (big, small, shake, nod, explode, ripple, bloom, jitter)
- 7. Tap the up arrow in upper right corner

Other Ways to Add Animation

Instead of using the A

- 1. Tap in the Message box
- 2. In the pop up, select Text Effects
- 3. Select your animation
- 4. Compose your text
- 5. Send

NOTE: This will animate the entire text

Animate the Message Bubble

Slam, Loud, Gentle, Invisible Ink

- 1. Animate the BUBBLE
- 2. Go to the Message app
- 3. In a new or existing conversation, type a message or insert an image or link
- 4. Touch and **hold** the up arrow, then tap the gray dots to preview different bubble effects (if you touch and not hold, message will send)
- 5. Select the one you want
- 6. Tap up arrow to send with effect or X to return to message

Animate the Message Screen

Echo, Spotlight, Balloons, Confetti, Love, Lasers, Fireworks

- 1. Animate effects over the full Screen
- 2. Go to Message app
- 3. In a new or existing conversation, type a message, insert a photo, or Memoji
- 4. Touch and hold up arrow
- 5. Tap Screen
- 6. Defaults to Echo
- 7. Swipe left to preview different screen effects
- 8. Tap up arrow to send of X to cancel effect and return to message
